Yard Trees. The trees between the curb and sidewalk, referred to as sidewalk trees, are owned by Chesterfield. If you have large dead branches, low hanging branches or a tree is dead, the homeowner (trustees cannot perform this service) must contact the city for service. Inform them of the specific problem(s). There are no charges for these services.

If one of your sidewalk trees has already been removed, or needs to be cut down now, the city has a great program to replace them. There is a co-pay required, and there are a list of trees that may be planted. See the city website for details of this program -
